Henley DBA student Staffan Canbäck has won the prestigious European Doctoral Thesis Competition run by the European Doctoral Association in Management and Business Administration. EDAMBA represents 50 of the major business schools in Europe. The award was presented in September 2003 in Budapest.

Staffan Canbäck's research looks at how the size of companies is actually limited by bureaucracy, and the effects of insularity, incentive limits and communication distortion, and is based on a study of 784 large manufacturing firms in the USA.
